## Cook-Off Rules & Regulations

#### **General Event Rules:**

- \* St. Kevin Catholic School prides itself in its family friendly environment. All themes, decor, and behavior must be in good taste. Team Captains are responsible for promoting this family friendly environment among his/her team.
- \* Each contestant competing shall supply **ALL** cooking ingredients, devices, untensils, preparation tables, tents, chairs, etc.
- \* All competitors are responsible for set-up and clean up of their area. They must also ensure that their cooking area is kept clean during the event. Hygiene must be a priority for all stations.
- \* No pets allowed.
- \* Competitors are prohibited from selling any items. Only registered vendors will be permitted to sell goods to the public.
- \* Wristbands purchase is required for tastings.
- \* All Teams are responsible for decorating their own tent and pig. At the end of the event there will be a People's Choice for Best Decorations.
- \* Violations of the Rules & Regulations of the contest may result in disqualifications.

## Pig:

- \* St. Kevin will provide the pig, cooking area, and sampling plates
- \* Pigs must be cooked in an above-ground cooker. No pits allowed.
- \* All cooking must be done on premises the day of the event. No exceptions. Teams may arrive as early as they need to.
- \* Pigs must be cooked to an internal temperature of 165 degrees.
- \* A safety buffer must be created around the cooking area.
- \* Gas cookers must meet all safety standards before the competition begins. A representative from St. Kevin will inspect all gas cookers.
- \* At the end of the event, contestants must make sure that all coal, wood, etc is extinguished and disposed of appropriately.
- \* The safety of all contestants and guests must be a priority.

#### **Side Dishes:**

- \* Sides dishes may be cooked on site or brought in pre-preared.
- \* Contestants are responsible for providing their own warmers if needed.
- \* Side dishes include chili, beans, pasta, salads, etc.
- \* Contestants must provide a minimum of 100 **small** sample plates, cups, napkins, etc depending on the nature of the dish for voting and sampling.
